Publishable Summary

This Deliverable presents with the on-line catalogue of Eco-Innovative Solutions (EIS), documenting, through a step-by-step guide, the methodology of Peri-Urban Living Labs (PULLs) developed by REPAiR and implemented in the six case studies.

The PULL methodology has been tested in the two REPAiR pilot cases and in the four follow-up cases producing six catalogues of EIS. The on-line tool shows the summary of the results achieved for each case in 6 posters, called 'Intermezzo' (figurative, from music & videogames: i.e. non interactive communication).

The aim of this on-line handbook is to share the PULL methodology widely, and to transfer it to researchers, public institutions and private parties, interested in implementing an Urban Living Lab.

Furthermore, a selection of significant EIS per each case has been made, and a search engine is available to look for EIS organised per flows, per cases and per keywords. Useful materials about the PULL methodology and about the selected EIS are made available to be downloaded - in high resolution - for everyone.
